// A special meeting of the Council of the City of Lynchburg was held on the 15th day of August, 2023, at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Stephanie Dolan, President, presiding. The following Members were present:

// In the matter of Schools, Agenda Item 1, Council considered a first reading of Resolution #R-23-069 amending Lynchburg City Schools Major Classification Funding for FY 2024. The FY 2024 Adopted Schools Operating Budget is amended by transferring \$261,000 from Contingency Reserves to Administration, Attendance and Health to provide resources for legal fees regarding desegregation (\$250,000) and professional development training (\$11,000). This request does not change the total operating revenues appropriated by City Council but rather moves \$261,000 from Contingency Reserves to Administration, Attendance and Health.

Vice Mayor Faraldi made the motion, seconded by Councilmember Wilder, to adopt the Resolution #R-23-069.

Councilmember Helgeson stated that requesting unitary status will help with closer-to-home rezoning and hopefully the full amount won't be needed.

With no further discussion from the Council, the following vote was recorded:
