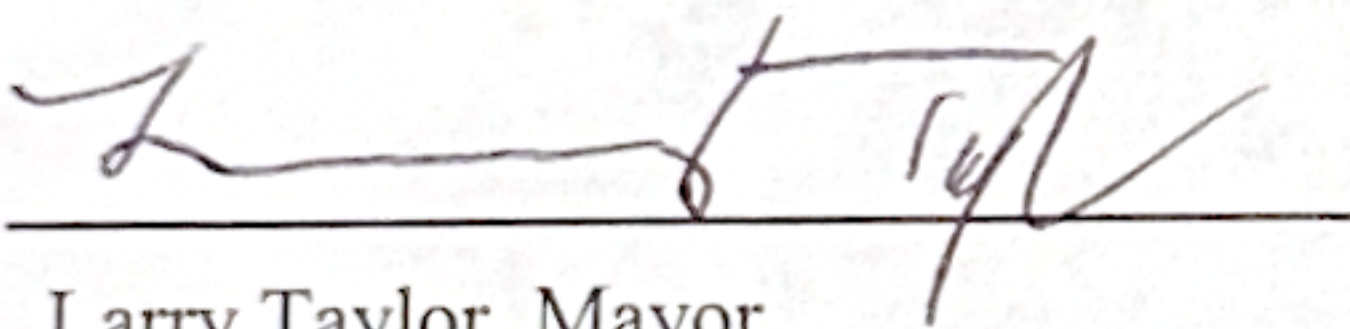

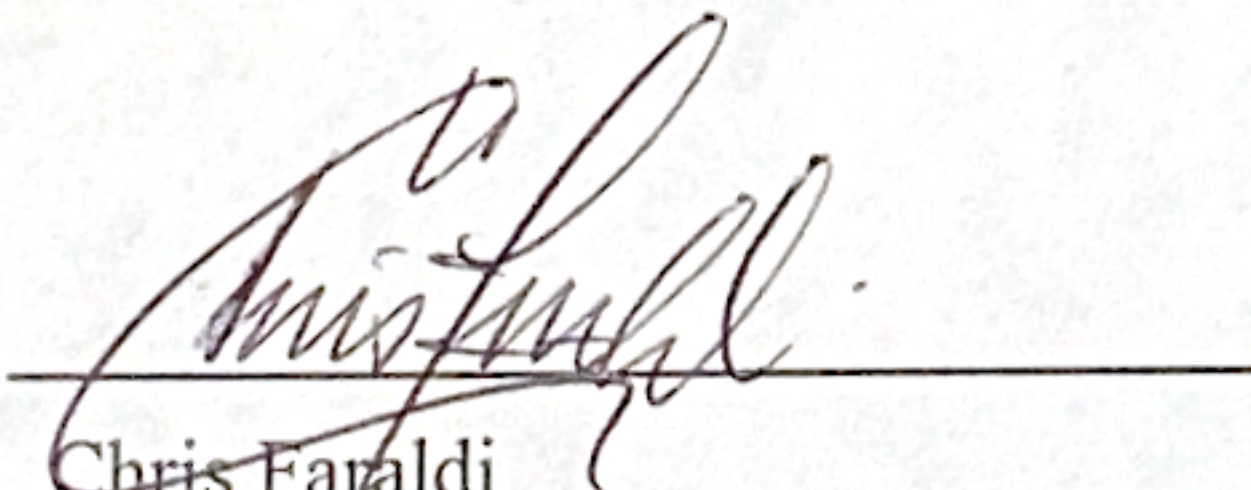

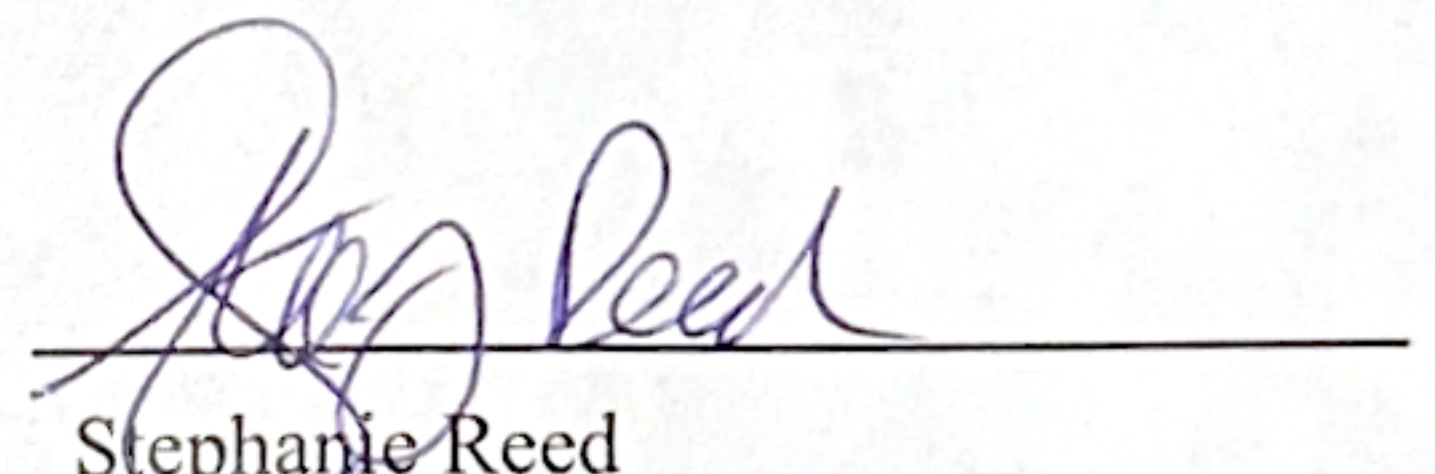

RESOLUTION:

#R-26-____

A RESOLUTION APPLAUDING THE DECISION TO TEMPORARILY PAUSE THE OPERATION OF THE CITY OF LYNCHBURG'S FIFTEEN (15) FIXED FLOCK GROUP, INC. ("FLOCK") CAMERAS, DECLARING UNWAVERING SUPPORT FOR THE MEN AND WOMEN OF THE LYNCHBURG POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND PROVIDING "NOTICE" AND LICENSE REVOCATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CONTRACTUAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LYNCHBURG AND FLOCK.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNCHBURG:

1. That the Council of the City of Lynchburg, Virginia (the "City") (i) applauds the August 19, 2026, decision of the City's Chief of Police and the City's Administration to temporarily pause the operation of the City's fifteen (15) fixed Flock Group, Inc. ("Flock") cameras; and (ii) declares its unwavering support for the men and women of the Lynchburg Police Department.
2. That, pursuant to Subsection 6.1 *Term* of Section 6. *Term and Termination* of the GOVERNMENT AGENCY AGREEMENT AMENDED AS OF THE 8TH DAY OF MAY 2023, included as Exhibit "A" under the REVOCABLE LICENSE AGREEMENT dated November 28, 2023, between Flock and the City (collectively the "Contract"), the adoption of this Resolution shall serve as "notice" to Flock as defined in the aforesaid Subsection. Further, pursuant to *Article 2. Term; Termination* of the said revocable license agreement, this Resolution shall also serve as written notice that Flock's license to operate in the City's rights-of-way and upon its property will be revoked upon such notice becoming effective.
3. That the Council recognizes that the fifteen (15) fixed Flock cameras currently located in the City's rights-of-way or on City property are "paused", and nothing in this Resolution shall be construed to direct, authorize, or require the resumption of their operation; further, the fifteen (15) fixed Flock cameras shall remain "paused" for the remainder of the Contract's term, pending final execution and/or the effectuation of this Resolution.
4. That the City Manager, or his designee, shall ensure the substance of this Resolution is effectuated no later than what is provided for under the Contract, after which all Flock technology shall be removed from the City's rights-of-way and its property.
