The purpose of the meeting was to conduct a public hearing regarding the Proposed FY 2014 Budget and the 2014-2018 Capital Improvement Program. The following Members were present:

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// City Manager Kimball Payne provided an overview regarding the FY 2014 Proposed Operating Budget and the FY 2014-2018 Capital Improvement Program for the City of Lynchburg, which includes funding for general government services, fleet, airport, schools, water, sewer, stormwater and other funds.

// In the matter of Budget, a public hearing was held regarding City Council Report #1 regarding the FY 2014 Proposed Operating Budget and the FY 2014-2018 Capital Improvement Program. During the public hearing a total of 17 individuals spoke concerning the following programs:

- 10 individuals spoke in favor of continuing funding for the Tourism Program
- 5 individuals spoke in favor of funding for Lynchburg Public Schools
- 1 individual spoke in favor of continued support for the Horizon Behavioral Health (formerly Central Virginia Community Services)
- 1 individual spoke in favor of continued support for the Greater Lynchburg Transit Company (GLTC)

There was no one else present who wished to speak to this item and the public hearing was closed.
